### **Directions:**

**Going South on Interstate 5  
from Los Angeles**

Take I-5 South, or I-15 South to I-8 west, to the Rosecrans exit. Rosecrans only goes one direction. Take Rosecrans 3 miles to N. Harbor Drive (traffic signal at Winchells Donuts). Turn left on N. Harbor Drive and go one block to Scott Street. Turn right on Scott Street and Immediately turn left into our parking lot.

## **The information about the deep sea tuna fishing trip**

**Trip and Services:** We will fish at 50 to 120 miles off San Diego, CA, the boat will search where school of tuna area to catch some specie of fish, include bluefin tuna, yellowfin tuna, albacore, yellowtail and dorado. Fisherman's Landing has a full service tackle shop for all your rod rentals, fishing license and tackle needs. Photo ID required for all passengers 18 and older. Bait, bunk and sack is included on trip. Ice chests, glass containers and alcoholic beverages are **not allow** to be brought aboard the boat. The boat's gallery will serve hot meals and drink. California or Mexico fishing licenses are **required** for all anglers 16 years of age and older. Licenses, food, beverages and fish filleting are **additional** on trip. If you don't have license, you need to buy from on the boat. It will cost between \$14-16 for one day trip. Limit to 22 anglers on the boat. **IMPORTANT NOTE: In order to get the guaranteed spot, you must pay in FULL amount. If you do the payment plan, you will be placed on the waiting list and not be guaranteed. If you are on the waiting list and later pay the balance in full, you will be moved the the guaranteed spot. First 22 anglers with full payment are guaranteed even with anglers on the waiting list. When 22 anglers have full payment, those who are on the waiting list will be refunded on the day of the trip.**

**What to Bring:** Fishing license, sunblock lotion, sunglasses, hand towel, camera, sea sickness medication, rubber boot or old shoe, warmer jacket with hood, hat or cap, rod/reel and tackle (see on below)

**Tackle:** Please bring your 20, 30, 40 pound monofilament line test rigs with leader of fluorocarbon 20-40 lb test line for most of our trip. Some times when the bigger fish are biting you will need heavier line too, 50 and 60 pound test rigs. The boat will provide heavier line if required, also borrow 80 lb test line rig for trolling. Please watch the fish counts to see what size fish we are catching. Also you need to bring 2 packages of #1 & #3/0 **TUNA** hook for live bait and 1/4 & 1/2 oz egg sinkers. If you don't own rod/reel or tackles. You need to rent and buy tackles from Fisherman's Landing. The rent rod cost \$15 for adult & \$12 for junior.
